We are writing to update you on the developing situation with COVID-19.

On March 15, 2020, Governor Inslee announced a new statewide proclamation to temporarily shut down restaurants, bars and entertainment and recreational facilities. In addition, all gatherings under 50 participants are prohibited unless previously announced criteria for public health and social distancing are met.

We strongly support all measures to protect the health of our patrons, artists, and staff. Given these new guidelines, RTOP will postpone *Thoroughly Modern Millie* along with all current and future operations until further notice. This includes the operations of our administrative staff.

This is an evolving crisis with many unknowns. If you are a ticket, season pass holder, or Performing Arts School Participant we will honor your purchase and will contact you as soon as our plans solidify. We will humbly add that transferring your purchase to a donation supports RTOP during these uncertain times.

Work-stoppage for a non-profit performing arts organization is always incredibly difficult, and a last resort. Unfortunately, we have arrived at that eventuality.
